Can we please remind everyone to return time request slips by Tuesday 24th September. Teachers will do their best to allocated times requested, however please be aware that this is not always possible.

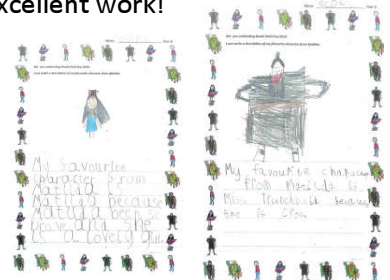
PACKED LUNCHES

LUNCHTIME/AFTERSCHOOL CLUBS

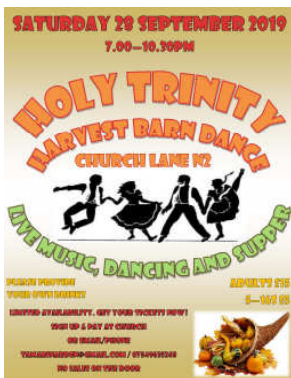

McMILLAN COFFEE MORNING

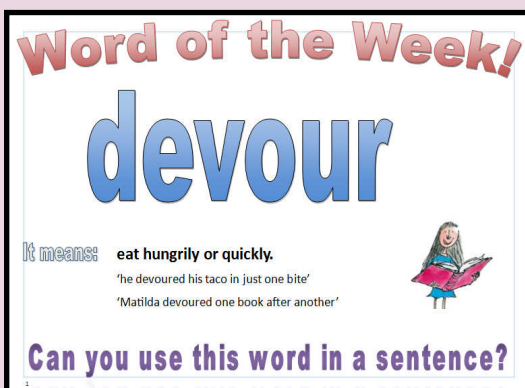
