
YEAR 2—KENYA

British Values 22nd – 28th March 2021 Rule of Law Every family must fill in their census form. It can be filled in using a paper form or on a computer and is done every 10 years!




The census helps children become more recognised by the Government. Every household must register their name, nationality and relationship to the other people who live with them.
