





Your Chance to represent the London Borough of Barnet in the Virgin Money Giving Mini London Marathon on 26th April 2020

> 5k trial race taking place on Saturday 1st February 2020 @ 9am, Oakhill Park, Barnet (race incorporated in the weekly Oakhill parkrun)

36 places available across the following three age groups (6 per group), for young people that live or go to school in the borough:

Boys and Girls - Under 13

Must be at least 11 years old on 26 April 2020 or 12 on 31 August 2019
Born between 1 September 2006 and 28 April 2009

Boys and Girls - Under 15

Must be 13 or 14 on 31 August 2019
Born between 1 September 2004 and 31 August 2006

Men and Women- Under 17

Must be aged 15 or 16 on 31 August 2019
Born between 1 September 2002 and 31 August 2004

#### REGISTERING MADE EASY

To register for the London Mini Marathon trial to represent Barnet you just need to follow this simple 2 stage process:

1. Register with parkrun on-line http://www.parkrun.org.uk/pak-hill/

Once registered, you will receive an email which has a link to print a barcode – click on the link  $\hat{a}$  print off your barcode which you will need to take with you.

If you are already registered but have lost your barcode you can get a reminder email via http://www.parkoup.org.uk/bak-hill/

Once you have received your barcode email ferenty soft-cott@btirtemet.com to advise that you will be attending the trial on 1\* February

If you cannot attend the trial on 1° February, then we can use any of your race results from the Oakhill Parkrun from 7th December 2019 to 22nd February 2020.

We are also selecting from an alternative Celchill race (same course) on Sunday 2nd Feb et Oakhill Park at 9am for any athletas that cannot compete on a Saturday for religious reasons.
