Plan from January 2017

Costs

We would like to offer a cost effective provision for all families. We are aware that removing the sibling discount increased costs for some of our families. We are therefore reducing the cost of the first hour from £6.00 to £5.00 (this is a saving of £1). We are also reducing the cost of the full session (3.30–6.00pm) from £11.00 to £10.00. As per our current policy we will continue to review costs termly.

These changes will come into effect from January 2017.

Staff Ratio

To ensure the safety and high quality provision for all children, we will continue to offer a ratio of 1:10 adults to children.

We will be supporting parents and carers to use the new system as soon as it is up and running. Look out for information in the newsletters.
