

LBL Holy Trinity - Holiday Learning Workshops

LBL are pleased to be partnering with Holy Trinity School to provide a series of learning workshops for children over the school holidays. Our first workshop will be in February half term 2019.

The workshops will be project-based and will focus on extending and developing core areas of the curriculum in a fun, relaxed and engaging way. We will focus primarily on activities which centre around a theme or project but will also incorporate wider elements of the foundation curriculum as well as crucial soft skills such as team building, leadership, mindfulness, communication and inter-personal skills.

What will my child be learning?

Our first workshop week will be based on 'The Greatest Showman' and the learning will be focused around the children designing their own circus and exploring the themes from the film. The learning plan for the week can be found overleaf, with the curriculum links and intended outcomes for children included.

The children will also be given plenty of free play opportunities throughout the day to ensure they remain fresh and engaged during the sessions. The overall aim is that they feel they have enjoyed the day and so this will be a key objective.

Who will run the workshops?

The workshops will be planned and linked to curriculum objectives by Fiona and the LBL Holy Trinity team, led by David Cullinan and Naomi Bates.

Fiona is a fully qualified teacher and former Head of PSCE, Deputy Head of English, Literacy and Intervention Coordinator with 10+ years' experience in education. She holds a PGCE in Secondary English, an MA and BA (hons) English Literature, an Advanced Diploma in Education, Child Behaviour Diploma as well as qualifications in Play Work and Early Years.

How do I book and how much does it cost?

Spaces are limited and advance booking for LBL Holy Trinity is essential. This is to ensure we have a full range of resources and materials available for each child. The workshops are charged at £30 per day and £26 for subsequent siblings. The workshops will run from 9am-4pm daily. We will also offer a walking bus service to LBL Martin School if parents require wraparound care between 8am-6pm for an additional charge of £10 per day. Who is this suitable for?

We will design and create activities and projects to suit all types of learners; we'll challenge and extend able and gifted learners to stretch their capabilities and will support and encourage children

with less confidence or who those would benefit from focused learning activities in a smaller, less formal setting. All are welcome and each child who attends will be challenged appropriately, pushed to reach their potential and will leave feeling as though they have achieved as well as having had a fun day!

Are you Ofsted registered?

As these are learning workshops as opposed to a childcare facility, we do not require an Ofsted registration. However, this setting will be run and managed with the same standards and principles as all our LBL settings, with a full set of policies and procedures and the same training and qualification requirements from staff, including Safeguarding training, DBS certificates and First Aid qualifications.

GDPR and Information Sharing

We will ask for parental permission to use data held by the school such as an EHCP or support plan if your child has one. All parents will complete a registration form and emergency contact form with medical and allergy information provided as a matter of course. However, additional information would be useful so we are able to plan for a suitable level of challenge. The staff involved will most likely already know this information as Holy Trinity staff, but it would be best practice to ask for consent to use it in an LBL context.
