


Starting With a Story

Remember to count down from 20 to blast off!






You will have developed a lot of pattern and shape skills by now. Create your own ABC Dinosaurs or just one big one to poop a planet!

That Dinosaur just keeps on pooping! Keep an eye on him! Can you tell us how many that would be?









Remember not to read the Ditty to your child first. As your child reads the Ditty, be patient and give your child plenty of praise.






Rocket Doubles Game

Do they have pets?


Will it be one that has been looked after or has it been eaten by a dinosaur? Will it have rivers or seas? Will it have islands?
