*Today we met for a catch up and to feed back about any issues, thoughts or ideas you may be having about your school.*

*Some children would like more gymnastics equipment and there was even talk of seeing whether Holy Trinity could have our very own gym. They also raised whether it would be possible for the children of Holy Trinity to design their own PE hoodie?*
