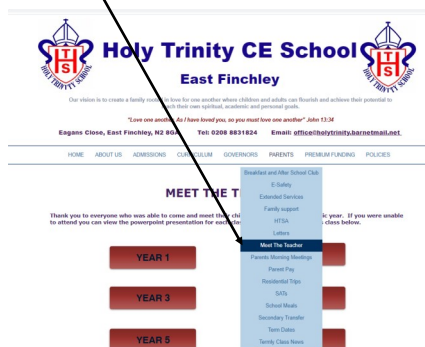

Then just click on your child's year group.

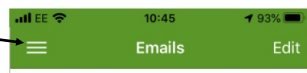


ONE TO ONE MEETINGS

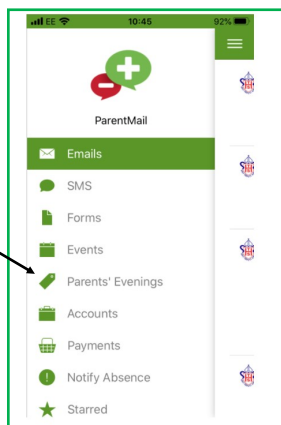

KEEPING IN TOUCH

We hope that the new coming in system has been mainly smooth for families. We are aware that this system does not give much time for a quick catch up at the gate. To ensure that your questions can be answered, we will be using the following ways to communicate:

Members of staff on the gate— there will be members of staff available for most drop off and pick up times, please feel free to talk to any of them.

For anything which needs to be dropped off to the office please use the DROP BOX which will be located outside the front entrance to the school and will be emptied once all the children are in school.

Class Teaching Assistant/Teacher— the class teaching assistant will be available most mornings if you have a quick question. The class teacher will be with their class most mornings and available after school.

School email— Please email the school office who will forward your questions to the class teacher. The class teacher or member of staff will get back to you as soon as they are available.

ClassDojo—this is a class 'noticeboard' where teachers can post reminders and notes from the class Teacher, ie PE days, non-school uniform day, general class reminders, etc.

ParentMail— any formal communications from the school ie newsletters, forms and letters.

Google Classroom— The instructions for this weeks homework has been posted in your child's class Google Classroom. Please have a look. This will help your child to familiarise themselves with logging on and handing in homework. Children in Years 1 and 2 and the Reception class may need support logging in.

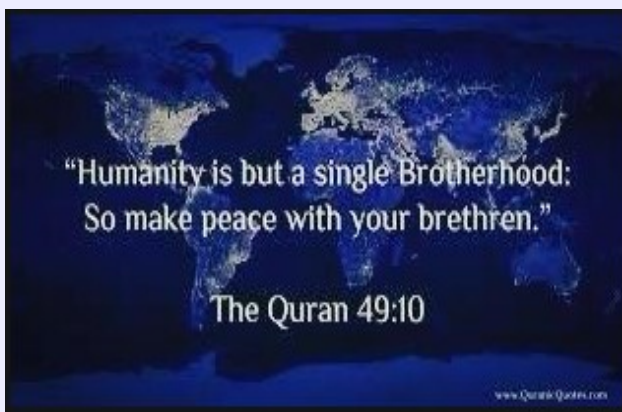
